CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

OCKOOKKENT KESOLUTTON	
To memorialize the United States Congress to protect	1
domestic auto manufacturers and to create a	2
federal infrastructure development program to	3
foster employment growth.	4
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE	
OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):	
WHEREAS, Domestic auto manufacturers, such as Ford Motor	5

Company and General Motors Company, are suffering great financial 6 difficulties and need assistance from the federal government in order to avoid filing for bankruptcy; and 8 WHEREAS, Ford Motor Company employs approximately 15,000 Ohio 9 residents and General Motors Company employs approximately 20,500 10 Ohio residents, all of whom could lose their jobs, including 11 health and retirement benefits, if the companies are forced to 12 file bankruptcy and close plants; and 13 WHEREAS, The domestic economy and domestic workers would 14 substantially benefit from a federal infrastructure development 15 program where the federal government would finance the repair, 16 expansion, and improvement of national railway systems, water 17 management systems, and power and electric systems; and 18 WHEREAS, Domestic auto manufacturers' plants are already 19 equipped with the appropriate machine tools and production 20 capability to assist in national infrastructure projects and this

assistance would prevent many plants in Ohio and other states from	22	
closing and experiencing subsequent job loss; and	23	
WHEREAS, It is the duty of the United States Congress to	24	
stimulate and sustain the national economy and foster employment	25	
for growing numbers of Ohio and United States citizens who would	26	
become unemployed and lose health and retirement benefits if	27	
domestic auto manufacturers continue to decline; now therefore be	28

RESOLVED, That the 126th General Assembly of the State of	30	
Ohio urges the Congress of the United States to protect the	31	
domestic auto industry and to create a federal infrastructure	32	
development program to utilize existing machine-tool resources and	33	
foster employment growth; and be it further	34	
RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives	35	
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the	36	
President of the United States, to the Speaker and the Clerk of	37	
the United States House of Representatives, to the President Pro	38	
Tempore and the Secretary of the United States Senate, to the	39	
members of the Ohio Congressional delegation, and to the news	40
