- Proactively advocate for the interests of the Ohio Chamber and the Ohio Small Business Council before policymakers.
- Produce summaries of and generate policy positions on pending legislation.
- Respond to requests from administration officials and members of the Ohio General Assembly.
- Attend state legislative committee hearings and draft testimony, identify and prepare witnesses to present testimony, and deliver testimony as appropriate.
- Identify, develop, and coordinate opportunities to educate and establish relationships with policymakers.
- Manage legislative tracking tool for identified key issues.
- Assist with the development, management and marketing of internal subject matter committees.
- Track engagement on federal issues.

Qualifications: Bachelors degree. At least two years experience in legislative analysis, policy development, or government affairs. Familiarity with state legislative and regulatory processes. Sound independent judgment and political acumen. Excellent verbal and written communications skills coupled with strong analytical and relationship-building skills.
