Toledo Museum of Art Master Plan Phase 1	\$5,000,000	To provide for the installation of new elevators to make the museum more accessible, renovation of the Glass Crafts Building to provide for art, conservation and storage, and creation of the Art Support Building.
Imagination Station Theater Experience	\$3,000,000	To provide for the construction of a new large screen format theater to enhance the education benefits of the science center and for community engagements.
Wood County Committee on Aging Senior Center	\$2,000,000	To provide for the construction of a new senior center in collaboration with BGSU College of Health and Human Service's Optimal Aging Institute.
Valentine Theatre Symphonic Acoustical Enhancement (Toledo Cultural Arts Center)	\$1,053,982	To provide for improved theater acoustics with a new acoustical shell and audio enhancement to provide for greater use of the facility. Additional portable risers would also be acquired.
Dental Center of NW Ohio Facility	\$1,500,000	To provide for the construction of a new facility for dental patients and dental hygiene training and education programs.
Danny Thomas Park Renovation (Historic South Initiative)	\$700,000	To provide for the redevelopment of a park in the Old South End of Toledo with lighting and new playground equipment. More than 1,000 neighborhood youth will be served with new football, baseball and soccer fields.
National Museum of the Great Lakes Expansion (Great Lakes Historical Society)	\$1,200,000	To provide for the construction of new traveling exhibit space, installation of an accessible pilot house, a permanent exhibit of the Robert Sellers Model and Art Collection, and administrative office space.
Great Lakes Museum of Natural History (Toledo Zoo)	\$1,000,000	To provide the renovation of the existing 1938 WPA Museum of Science building for exhibit space and creation of an indoor theater available for community events and education.
Perrysburg Heights Community Center Multipurpose Room Addition (Perrysburg Heights Community Association)	\$500,000	To provide for the expansion of the existing facility to provide additional services and programming options for several hundred youth in the area. The addition of a multipurpose room will provide space for multiple activities to take place at the same time.
Wolcott House Heritage Center	\$1,500,000	The construction of a new multi-purpose facility to provide meeting space, exhibit and storage areas, and to create accessible restrooms for the complex.
Sylvania Downtown Streetscape	\$500,000	To provide for the completion of the streetscape enhancements and ADA accessibility in the downtown district.
ProMedica Mobile Health Clinic	\$500,000	To provide a mobile health clinic to provide employees of businesses in underserved areas with access to health services in an effort to increase productivity and safety.
UT/OSHP Shared Public Safety Building (University of Toledo)	\$800,000	To provide for a new shared public safety facility to serve the University of Toledo and the Ohio State Highway Patrol.
East Wooster Street Redevelopment (Bowling Green State University)	\$250,000	To provide for the development of the corridor between the interstate and downtown area.

Owens Community College Center for Emergency Preparedness	\$500,000	To provide for the purchase of new equipment, expansion and renovation of existing structures, and construction of new training space to better meet the training needs of first responders in the region.
Mercy College Learning Commons and Classroom Expansion (Mercy College of Ohio/Northwest State Community College)	\$700,000	To provide for the renovation of current space for additional classroom and other learning areas to assist in meeting an in-demand career field.
Manhattan Marsh Park Development (Metroparks Toledo)	\$691,983	To provide for the development of a 70-acre park and facilities for public access and educational programing.
Comprehensive Advocacy Center for Victims of Domestic and Sexual Violence (The Cocoon)	\$1,221,731	To provide facility renovations to create a comprehensive advocacy center in addition to services provided in the emergency shelter. Additionally, further upgrades to the building for improved energy efficiency, accessibility and security are also planned.
