### CSRAB Security Facility Committee Recommendations to the Board

The CSRAB Board accepted the Security Facility Committee recommendations at the CSRAB Board meeting on April 18, 2013 as follows:

- There will be four doors open for the public and Ohio Statehouse staff to enter during business hours:

Garage South Sliders  
West Rotunda Door\*  
State Street Rotunda Door\*  
Senate Building Third Street Doors

\*(Doors will not be open on weekends)

- Each entry will have an OHP officer at all times while the doors are unlocked.
- Each entry will be equipped with two hand-held security metal wand scanners, a small table and a ballistic desk or podium.
- Each entry will have two security cameras with a TV monitor and a telephone.
- The Garage South Slider, West Rotunda and one of the Third Street doors will have a card reader for after-hours entry for authorized staff only.
- Ten doors will be alarmed with a 15-second delay before opening and will have security cameras on them.
- Three doors will be alarmed with a 15-second delay override if an authorized pass is used. Pass card readers will be installed inside and outside of these doors. These doors will be protected not to allow piggybacking to occur.
- Signs will be posted that briefcases and carry-in packages are subject to be inspected.
- Special entry passes will be furnished to authorized lobbyists at a cost of the pass card.
- All contractors who work at Capitol Square will be given a contractor pass card that must be displayed in clear view when on site. These cards are to be picked up and returned daily.
