### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **Air Transport Services Group, Inc. City of Wilmington, Clinton County**

On October 27, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.338 percent, 7-year tax credit for Air Transport Services Group, Inc. (“ATSG.”) for the creation of \$3,594,240 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the City of Wilmington, Clinton County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least ten years.

ATSG provides air cargo transportation, maintenance, and related services to air carriers and other companies that outsource their air cargo lift requirements.

Ohio is competing with Indiana and Kentucky for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by ATSG in the City of Wilmington, Clinton County, involves expanding operations at the Wilmington Air Park and relocating key maintenance functions from CVG. The project includes hiring and training technicians, facility upgrades, and new ground support equipment. Driven by growing demand from large customers, this investment will create high-skill jobs and strengthen Ohio’s aviation infrastructure.

ATSG expects to create 48 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$3,594,240 in new annual payroll and retain \$47,580,000 in existing payroll by 12/31/2028 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated August 21, 2025, the Clinton County Port Authority expressed support for the project.
