SCOPE OF WORK

Axium Packaging, LLC Jersey Township and City of New Albany, Licking County

On October 8, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.230 percent, 8-year tax credit for Axium Packaging, LLC (“Axium Packaging”) for the creation of \$3,640,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in Jersey Township and the City of New Albany, Licking County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least eleven years.

Axium Packaging is one of the leading producers of high-quality plastic packaging for personal care, food, home, hygiene, and other products. Axium manufactures injection molded plastics and specializes in decorating technologies.

Ohio is competing with Illinois and Missouri for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Axium Packaging in Jersey Township and the City of New Albany, Licking County, involves building a new facility to add capacity for tube manufacturing and specialized warehouse operations.

Axium Packaging expects to create 70 full-time equivalent employees generating \$3,640,000 in new annual payroll and \$62,088,712 in existing payroll by 12/31/2028 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated August 28, 2025, the GROW Licking County expressed support for the project.
