SCOPE OF WORK

Church & Dwight Co., Inc. Village of Old Fort, Seneca County

On October 27, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.304 percent, 7-year tax credit for Church & Dwight Co., Inc. (“Church & Dwight”) for the creation of \$3,000,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the Village of Old Fort, Seneca County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least ten years.

Church & Dwight develops, manufactures and markets a range of household, personal care and specialty products.

Ohio is competing with Illinois and Missouri for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Church & Dwight in the Village of Old Fort, Seneca County, involves the reconfiguration of its current manufacturing facility and upgrades to its rail system to increase its capacity to meet increased demand for its new product line.

Church & Dwight expects to create 40 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$3,000,000 in new annual payroll and retain \$28,799,935 in existing payroll by 12/31/2029 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated August 28, 2025, the Seneca County Collaborative expressed support for the project.
