



## **EXHIBIT I**

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **Melink Solar, LLC Symmes Township, Hamilton County**

On June 2, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.561 percent, 7-year tax credit for Melink Solar, LLC (“Melink Solar”) for the creation of \$3,600,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in Symmes Township, Hamilton County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least ten years.

Melink Solar designs, procures, and installs solar energy systems for commercial and industrial clients. They specialize in delivering turnkey renewable energy solutions and ongoing system maintenance.

Ohio is competing with Kentucky for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Melink Solar in Symmes Township, Hamilton County, includes opening a new headquarters facility that will serve as a hub for office functions, employee training, and product displays.

Melink Solar expects to create 30 full-time equivalent employees generating \$3,600,000 in new annual payroll and retain \$3,150,190 in payroll by 12/31/2027 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated May 7, 2025, Symmes Township expressed support for the project.
