SCOPE OF WORK

Poly6 Technologies, Inc. City of Eastlake, Lake County

On December 15, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.597 percent, 9-year tax credit for Poly6 Technologies, Inc. (“Poly6”) for the creation of \$10,500,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the City of Eastlake, Lake County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least twelve years.

Poly6 develops “intelligent materials” that enable digital and additive manufacturing solutions that integrate into existing production lines especially in high-precision industries like aerospace and energy.

Ohio is competing with Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and South Carolina for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Poly6 in the City of Eastlake, Lake County, involves the addition of a new location in Ohio to scale production for its key customer. Poly6 will invest \$20,500,000 for its proposed project, including \$13,000,000 in machinery and equipment costs and \$7,500,000 in building costs.

Poly6 expects to create 164 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$10,500,000 in new annual payroll by 12/31/2029 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated October 20, 2025, the City of Eastlake expressed support for the project.
