SCOPE OF WORK

Prentke Romich Company Wooster Township, Wayne County

On October 27, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.468 percent, 8-year tax credit for Prentke Romich Company (“Prentke Romich”) for the creation of \$5,100,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in Wooster Township, Wayne County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least eleven years.

Prentke Romich is a worldwide leader in the development and manufacturing of augmentative communication devices, computer access products, and other assistive technology for adults and children with a wide range of complex communication disorders.

Ohio is competing with India for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Prentke Romich in Wooster Township, Wayne County, will consist of the reconfiguration of approximately 28,500 square feet of office space to accommodate an expanding workforce of in-house and hybrid employees.

Prentke Romich expects to create 60 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$5,100,000 in new annual payroll and retain \$17,108,642 in existing payroll by 12/31/2028 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated September 15, 2025, the Wayne Economic Development Council expressed support for the project.
