SCOPE OF WORK

Revere Plastics Systems, LLC City of Clyde, Sandusky County

On December 15, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.463 percent, 8-year tax credit for Revere Plastics Systems, LLC (“Revere Plastics Systems”) for the creation of \$18,500,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the City of Clyde, Sandusky County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least eleven years.

Revere Plastics Systems specializes in designing, developing, manufacturing, & supplying custom-engineered plastic injection molded components & assemblies. Their manufacturing capabilities include various molding techniques for various industries.

Ohio is competing with Indiana, Iowa, Kansas and Michigan as well as the countries of Canada and Mexico for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Revere Plastics Systems in the City of Clyde, Sandusky County, involves a \$111,000,000 investment in machinery and equipment to meet new demand resulting from its contact with a new customer to provide a component that's critical to new technology in the aqueous zinc battery space.

Revere Plastics Systems expects to create 378 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$18,500,000 in new annual payroll and retaining \$14,023,875 in existing payroll by 12/31/2028 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated August 4, 2025, the Sandusky County Economic Development Corporation expressed support for the project.
