



## **EXHIBIT I**

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **Riverain Technologies, Inc. City of Springboro, Montgomery County**

On December 15, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.978 percent, 8-year tax credit for Riverain Technologies, Inc. (“Riverain”) for the creation of \$9,600,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the City of Springboro, Montgomery County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least eleven years.

Riverain is a medical software research and development company that develops solutions to aid radiologists in the early detection of disease.

Ohio is competing with California for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Riverain in the City of Springboro, Montgomery County, involves additional research and development engineers to accelerate CT scanning product development to help detect early lung cancer cases and increase market share.

Riverain expects to create 48 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$9,600,000 in new annual payroll and retain \$6,400,000 in existing payroll by 12/31/2028 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated November 10, 2025, the City of Springboro expressed support for the project.
