Am. H. B. No. 188 Hall, T., Synenberg, et al. – To create the Ohio Israel Trade and Innovation Partnership.

H. B. No. 195 Isaacsohn, Mathews, A. – To make changes to the Ohio Uniform Commercial Code.

H. B. No. 386 Odioso, Abrams, et al. – To require identity verification with photo identification when applying for a marriage license.

H. B. No. 430 Hiner, Miller, K., et al. – To designate a portion of State Route 13 in Knox County as the "Ohio State Highway Patrol Lt. Vance M. Andrews Memorial Highway."
