



## **EXHIBIT I**

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **The Ohio Art Company City of Bryan, Williams County**

On October 27, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.170 percent, 6-year tax credit for The Ohio Art Company (“Ohio Art”) for the creation of \$2,712,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the City of Bryan, Williams County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least nine years.

Ohio Art specializes in metal printing/lithography and manufacturing of other tin-based products, specifically for consumer products.

Ohio is competing with New Jersey for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Ohio Art in the City of Bryan, Williams County, involves facility upgrades and the purchase of machinery and equipment required to consolidate its operations between Ohio and New Jersey by moving its manufacturing operations from New Jersey.

Ohio Art expects to create 53 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$2,712,000 in new annual payroll and retain \$3,260,000 in existing payroll by 12/31/2028 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated May 13, 2025, the Williams County Economic Development Corporation expressed support for the project.
