SCOPE OF WORK

Vallourec Star, LP City of Youngstown, Mahoning County

On October 27, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.126 percent, 7-year tax credit for Vallourec Star, LP (“Vallourec Star”) for the creation of \$2,329,600 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the City of Youngstown, Mahoning County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least ten years.

Vallourec Star is a leading producer of high-quality seamless steel pipe, supplying the Oil Country Tubular Goods market on a global level.

Ohio is competing with Texas for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Vallourec Star in the City of Youngstown, Mahoning County, involves the expansion of its current operations to manufacture a newly developed and industrialized production line and meet increased demand from the North American Oil Country Tubular Goods market.

Vallourec Star expects to create 40 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$2,329,600 in new annual payroll and retain \$79,551,154 in existing payroll by 12/31/2028 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated June 20, 2025, the City of Youngstown expressed support for the project.
