SCOPE OF WORK

Wieland Chase, LLC City of Montpelier, Williams County

On December 15, 2025, the Ohio Tax Credit Authority (“Authority”) approved a 1.298 percent, 7-year tax credit for Wieland Chase, LLC (“Chase Brass & Copper”) for the creation of \$3,100,000 in new annual payroll as a result of the company’s project in the City of Montpelier, Williams County. As part of the tax credit agreement, the Authority requires the company to maintain operations at the project location for at least ten years.

Chase Brass & Copper manufactures brass rods and has a brass forging operation. The company was purchased by Wieland Corporation in 2019, opening them to new capabilities including ammunition. Key customers include plumbing OEMs, machine shops and ammunition producers.

Ohio is competing with Kentucky for this proposed project. State support will help ensure the proposed project moves forward in Ohio.

The proposed project by Chase Brass & Copper in the City of Montpelier, Williams County, involves the integration of new brass wire technology for more efficient ammunition manufacturing. Chase Brass & Copper will invest \$27,965,000 for its proposed project, including \$19,376,000 in machinery & equipment costs and \$8,589,500 in building costs.

Chase Brass & Copper expects to create 43 full-time equivalent employees, generating \$3,100,000 in new annual payroll and retaining \$27,284,802 in existing payroll by 12/31/2030 at the project location. In addition, the company will claim the tax credit on Ohio employee payroll generated at the project location in excess of the company’s baseline payroll at the project location.

By letter dated July 18, 2025, the Williams County Economic Development Corporation expressed support for the project.
