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"Sec. 141.16. (A) Any voluntarily retired judge, or any
judge who is retired under Section 6 of Article IV, Ohio
Constitution, may be assigned with the judge's consent, by the
chief justice or acting chief justice of the supreme court, to
active duty as a judge. While so serving, the judge shall be
paid, from money appropriated for this purpose, the established
compensation for such office, computed on a per diem basis, in
addition to any retirement benefits to which the judge may be
entitled.

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(B) Annually, on the first day of August, the
administrative director of the supreme court shall issue a

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18 billing to the ~~county treasurer~~ administrative judge of ~~any~~
19 ~~county~~ the court to which such a judge is assigned for
20 reimbursement of the county's portion of the compensation
21 previously paid by the state for the twelve-month period
22 preceding the last day of June. The county's portion of the
23 compensation shall be that part of each per diem paid by the
24 state which is proportional to the county's share of the total
25 compensation of a resident judge of such court. The ~~county~~
26 ~~treasurer~~ appropriate funding authority shall forward the
27 payment within thirty days.

28 (C) A retired assigned judge is eligible to receive a
29 retired assigned judge payment if the retired assigned judge
30 completes not less than one hundred hours of service in the
31 preceding quarter as assigned by the chief justice or acting
32 chief justice. The payment shall be seven hundred fifty dollars
33 per quarter and shall be paid from money appropriated for this
34 purpose. The payment is subject to any and all applicable taxes
35 under local, state, and federal law.

36 The payment shall be paid within thirty days after the end
37 of the quarter in which the one hundred hours is served.

38 (D) Division (C) of this section does not affect any right
39 of a retired assigned judge to receive any allowance, annuity,
40 pension, or other benefit vested pursuant to Chapter 145. of the
41 Revised Code or other eligible retirement system pursuant to
42 Ohio law.

43 (E) As used in this section:

44 (1) "Retired assigned judge" is a judge that is described
45 in division (A) of this section.

46 (2) "Quarter" is the preceding three-month period ending

on the last day of the month of March, June, September, or 47
December of each year. " 48
